We will be having a Kindergarten transition meeting here at Chamberlain on March 28th from 5:30-6:30 p.m. This will be for students who are transitioning from daycare, PreK, or a home based environment into our school next year. They will be able to meet the teachers and visit their classrooms. Spread the word! No paperwork is needed during this meeting, it is basically a meet and greet informative session.

Kindergarten Round-up is scheduled for April 20th from 8:30-10:30 am. Please call the office at 304-348-1969 if you have any questions regarding this process. To help with the registration of your child for Kindergarten next year you will need to bring the following information:

- Immunization record
- Certified birth certificate from the state of birth with a raised seal.
- Your street address with proof of residency for that address, such as a utility bill, rental contract, etc..., that will show your name and that address.
- Other information that you will need are telephone numbers for you (home, cell, work), and two persons who will be responsible for your child if you cannot be reached; physician's name and telephone;

dentist name and telephone number; name and numbers of medical insurance; current health issues; health history; medications, allergies; and restrictions, if any. You will also need to bring copies of your child's recent physical and dental exams.

- Please make sure that you bring your child to the Kindergarten Round-up so that they can be screened for vision, hearing, dental, and speech.
